Dennis, our church in Victoria asked for some prayer points so they can pray this coming Sunday so I thought I would send this to you as well.

You can pray about the following:

1. Our current team members. Of the people in the picture everyone, except for the four people on the right-hand side, are going to the OMF Mekong field. We all started in Singapore together and are continuing on together. The couple to our left are David and Andrea Sutherland and their three children James-7, Harry-5 and Grace-2, from Australia. The couple to our left are Bill and Jennifer Crowder from Saskatchewan.
2. Our Neighbors. The house with the open gate on the right of the picture is ours. It is about 4 metres wide and about 12 metres deep. Not too big but it is fine for us. Please pray that we will get to know our neighbors and that we can be a positive influence in our community. We have already had a little to do with the family across the street. He likes flowers and we went out on Saturday and bought some flowers for the front of our house to brighten things up a little.
3. Our language learning. We attend school from Tuesday to Saturday and have two hours of personalized one-to-one instruction. We spend another 4 hours studying and preparing for the following day. The Thai language is very musical once you get to start listening but unlike English where we use tones to indicate the meaning for a whole sentence - "Gord is cold." or "Gord is cold?" - in Thai every word can have as many as 5 different tones with five different meanings. The possibility for misunderstanding is exponential!
